Event Descriptions

May 6 --Ice Breaker-Bowling at AMF Olympic Lanes (Grades 2-6)****

This is our first event and will take place at Olympic Lanes, located at 1350 Scottsville Rd. Children of Hillel and Boys & Girls Club will meet for the first time and have the opportunity to bowl together and get to know one another. Kosher snacks will be brought to the bowling alley. Parent pick-up will be at Hillel at approximately 5:30pm. Vans will be available for transportation to and from bowling.

May 13 Across the Globe- Capoeira Movement & Chinese Arts (Grades 3-7)

Join us for a "hands on" afternoon of cultural learning and creation. For half the session, student will learn about "Capoeira", a Brazilian art form and self-defense method, with strong aerobic and dance elements. This is an active session where students will learn about Capoeira, the instruments used in it and have the opportunity to try and demonstrate basic martial arts techniques. Then students will leave Brazil and travel to the Far East to explore China and learn Chinese as well as create calligraphy to take home.

May 20 **Build-A-Bear/Hippo (Grades K-5)**

*This is the first time EVER that a Boys & Girls Club Partnership event has been opened up to Kindergarten & First grade students so we hope younger children will take advantage of this opportunity. The venue for this event will be the **Build-A-Bear store located in Eastview Mall**. Hillel will cover the cost of the basic bear for each child but additional items for bears may be purchased at the store--we have heard that they sell Hippos too! Kosher snacks will be brought to the event. Parent pick-up will be at Hillel around 5:45/6:00pm, depending on traffic. Transportation vans will be available to and from Hillel.*

May 27 Computers and Digital Photography (Grades 3-7)

Children will partner up and work in Hillel's computer lab to create slideshows and use graphic effects to alter photos. Students will be able to print out and take home some of their designs.

June 3 Parachute Party with Dave Rogachefsky (Grades 2-6)

Our favorite Physical Education teacher Dave will host fun, favorite outdoor activities for the kids, using various gym equipment and of course, everyone's favorite, the parachute. We hope you will join us and sign up for an exciting and entertaining afternoon filled with movement and laughter.

June 17 **Farewell & Outdoor Party at Seneca Park Zoo (Grades 3-7)**

Lions and Tigers and Bears—Oh My! Well, not quite but there will be plenty of animals to enjoy when we venture to the Seneca Park Zoo for our final event. Children will pair up with a partner from a different school and together they will complete an activity book/scavenger hunt, using the animals and exhibits in the zoo. Transportation vans will be available to and from Hillel. Pick up from this event will be closer to 6:00pm due to travel.
